KENNEBEC RIVER

The Kennebec River winds through 12 miles of remote spectacular Maine Wilderness. Let our Registered Maine Guides share their enthusiasm and knowledge of the river as they lead you through the exciting Kennebec Gorge, making up the first 6 miles of the trip, and filled with continuous Class III-IV rapids like Rock Garden, Big Mamma, Whitewasher, and Magic Falls.

The Kennebec River trip is a 12 mile trip. The first 6 miles are continuous exciting Class III+IV rapids. After that, enjoy a nice boat float, swim in the river, or take a turn on an inflatable kayak. We stop for a riverside barbecue of grilled chicken and fresh summertime salads. This day starts around 8 AM with orientation and gearing up, then we bus up to the dam and hit the water around 10, we enjoy 4 or so hours on the river and expect to be back at base around 2 for folks to change and view a slideshow of the trip photos.

Controlled dam releases guarantee a full summer of whitewater action, 7 days a week!

Our Kennebec River Rafting trip costs:

- Saturday- \$99 per person
- Sunday – Friday \$89 per person

(Minimum of six people to book a trip)

- Professional whitewater guide in each custom NRS raft
- All equipment including paddle, life jacket, and helmet
- Hearty riverside cookout
- All transportation to and from the river
- Inflatable kayak included for each boat
