



Kennebec River Tubing (CLASS 1)

River tubing makes a great “Second Day” activity as well as a more relaxing alternative for those who don’t wish to go white water rafting in Maine. Bask in the summer sun and breathe in the fresh air as you take in the amazing views of the Lower Kennebec River!

Tubing trips begin at 12PM daily.

These trips begin at Three Rivers Whitewater in The Forks, ME. You’ll check in at the Three Rivers Trading Post where you can stock up on lunch, snacks, drinks, and adult beverages. If you’d like to bring food and drinks with you on the river, we recommend reserving an extra tube to carry your cooler.

From here, a shuttle will take you 2.8 miles north to the put in at the Inn By The River.

When the shuttle drops you off at the put-in, our guides will provide you with a personal floatation device (PFD) & your tubes – it’s that easy!

Once you’ve listened to our safety speech, you are off on your very own Maine river tubing adventure. The day is yours to relax and play on the river. The tubes can tether to each other so your group can float down together.

It is important to note that tubing is a self-guided activity. You will not have a guide with you on the water, so you will be responsible for your own safety. Minimum age is 5 (must know how to swim).

Make sure to keep your eyes peeled for wildlife, especially for bald eagles, who frequent the banks of the Lower Kennebec. This is also a perfect opportunity to bring along a waterproof camera to capture your favorite Maine memories. Make sure to tag us at @threeriverswhitewater to get featured on social media!

The trip is 6.5 miles long and typically takes 2.5 to 3 hours to complete. There will be a shuttle waiting for you at the take out spot to bring you right back to our base.

Kennebec River Rafting (CLASS III-IV)

The Kennebec River Rafting Trip is Maine's most popular river trip – and for good reason! This Maine whitewater rafting trip is known for its breathtaking wilderness setting and exhilarating high-volume whitewater rapids. The Kennebec River rafting trip is great for both beginners and experienced rafters alike. Whether it's your first time whitewater rafting or your 10th, this will be an unforgettable experience for you and your crew!

Your Kennebec River Rafting Adventure:

Check-in for your Kennebec Rafting Trip starts at 9:00am. After check-in, we outfit you with your river gear: life jackets and helmets are provided, while wet suits and splash jackets are available to rent at a small cost. Lastly, before we take you to the river, all rafters must participate in the Trip Leader's safety speech.

Your epic day on the river starts at Harris Station – Maine's largest hydroelectric dam. Before you hit the river, you will learn your guide's commands and practice paddling. When you begin your Maine rafting trip, don't forget to take in the scenery – the steep rock walls that line both sides of the river are stunning.

The Kennebec River Rafting Trip's first rapid is a Class II rapid – this serves as warm up for the bigger rapids downstream. Soon after, you will be charging into Seriously Fun Class IV rapids like Big Mama and The Alleyway. Many people compare these big, splashy sections of river to a roller coaster ride – except way more fun!

After the first section of major rapids, your trip will stop to enjoy "The Cathedral" – a calm section of river with amazing views. Here your guide will go over the plan for the biggest and most exciting rapid of the day – Magic Falls. This is where the stoke levels will reach their peak!

For the next few miles, you will tackle 3 fun and splashy Class III rapids. Once you're through the final rapid of the day, you'll get to enjoy a 6 mile float through the heart of Maine's wilderness. Your guide will provide you with a snack and be on the lookout for Bald Eagles. Don't forget to hop in the river and go for a float – It's plenty deep in most places and the water will be about 70 degrees in the middle of the summer!

Post Trip:

Your Kennebec river rafting trip concludes with a 3 minute bus ride back to the Forks Fun Resort. Once we are back to the base, your Guides will prepare lunch for you. After you eat you'll watch the photo/video presentation to see how you and your crew looked while conquering the Class IV Rapids.
