

THE BAR

Our lodge bar is open seasonally and does not have set hours. It is typically closed on weekends for private events, but when not reserved, we do open it to the public during the summer & winter months. Current hours and availability are posted on the lodge doors.

ALCOHOL POLICY

You are welcome to enjoy your own alcohol at your cabin. However, due to our liquor license, personal alcohol is not allowed within the fenced area around the lodge. Any alcohol consumed in that space must be purchased from our bar.

Additionally, alcohol purchased from the bar must remain within the lodge area and cannot be taken back to the cabins.

RENTAL GUIDELINES:

Grills

There is a propane grill available for use on the deck, we will provide the propane tank. Please make sure to clean the grill off after use.

Fire Pits

There is a propane firepit on the deck. If you would like to have a wood fire, there is a firepit available just down the driveway down the trail across from Cabin #7.

Heating & Cooling

The house has a furnace for heating in the cooler months and in the summer months we install a few window A/C units.

Laundry

There is a washer and dryer in the upstairs bathroom available for use. You will want to bring your own detergents.

Trash & Recycling

Trash can be placed in the RED dumpster in the Main Lodge parking lot.

Bottles/Cans: Place bagged recyclables next to dumpster.



TAKE A HIKE

MOXIE FALLS

Distance: 1.5 Difficulty: Easy

Highlights: Highest waterfall in New England (92 ft), scenic views, boardwalks, wildlife

sightings

Directions: From our driveway turn left. Take Rt. 201 North to The Forks. Turn right onto Lake Moxie Rd just before the Kennebec River bridge. Trailhead is ~2 miles in, marked by a

sign and parking area

ADVENTURE BOUND NATURE TRAIL

Distance: I mile loop Difficulty: Easy Highlights: Great for kids and families, Kennebec River views, educational wildlife and geology signs

Directions: From your cabin, walk toward the driveway split to Silver Cove Cabins. Follow the white signs with the Adventure Bound logo to start the trail. (Note: Respect Adventure Bound's family-friendly environment — no alcohol/substances.)

APPALACHAIN TRAIL TO PLEASANT POND

Distance: 10 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Highlights: Appalachian Trail section, mountain

and pond views, camping options

Directions: From our driveway turn left, drive north about 1.6 miles to the second entrance into Caratunk. The AT trailhead is just past the entrance on the right. Parking available on the hill or along Main Street.

FORKS AREA SCENIC TRAIL

connects to Moxie Falls

Distance: 6 miles Difficulty: Easy to Moderate Highlights: Great for walking, biking, or hiking with kids/dogs, follows Kennebec River,

Directions: Drive 2 miles north on Rt. 201 from the lodge. Look for circular opening/parking along the river. Trail runs north to The Forks and south through the campground.

BALD MOUNTAIN TRAIL

Distance: 9.6 miles Difficulty: Strenuous

Elevation: 2,630 ft

Highlights: Expansive summit views (Bigelow, Katahdin, Sugarloaf), mossy forest trail, AT lean-to Directions: From our driveway turn left. Take Rt. 201 North to The Forks. Turn right onto Lake Moxie Road. At the Lake Moxie Station/dam, turn right onto Troutdale Road. Drive ~8 miles to the AT marker and parking. Trail begins on the left, crosses a brook, and leads to Joe's Hole lean-to (1 mile in).

PLEASANT POND MOUNTAIN

Distance: 3 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Elevation: 2,477 ft

Highlights: Open summit, 360° views, steep but

rewarding hike

Directions: From our driveway turn left. From Rt. 201, turn right at the first Caratunk entrance (across from Adventure Bound). At 0.3 miles, turn right across from the Post Office. Continue ~3.7 miles to road fork, stay left. Drive 1.3 (the road turns to gravel after 0.3 mile), then turn right onto a narrow gravel drive, which leads to the trailhead parking area in 0.1 mile. AT signs mark the drive and the trailhead, which is at the far end of the grass parking area.

MOSQUITO MOUNTAIN

Distance: 4 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Elevation: 2,215 ft

Highlights: Open summit, 360° views, steep but

rewarding hike


Directions: From our driveway turn left. Take Rt. 201 North to The Forks. Turn right onto Lake Moxie Road, just before the Kennebec River bridge and go 5.3 miles. Turn right onto Troutdale Road and go 1.9 miles to a pull out where the road and power lines meet. Across the road is a camp at 412 Troutdale Rd. The trailhead is marked by a faded red bear paw on a rock, likely hidden behind some branches on the right side of the parking area as you look uphill. There are some fresher orange blazes marking the trail.

TRAIL ACCESS

During the winter, guests have direct access to ITS 87 snowmobile trails right from our property. While we do not have direct ATV trail access in the summer, the nearest park & ride locations are just 5 minutes away at Northern Outdoors in The Forks or 20 minutes south near Jimmy's Market in Bingham. For local trail maps and updates, check out Lake Moxie ATV Riders and Moose Alley Riders ATV Club (our neighboring southern club) on Facebook.

SCENIC DRIVING LOOP

- Starting at Maine Lakeside, take Route 201 North on the Old Canada Road Scenic Byway through Caratunk Village and then on to The Forks, where the Dead and Kennebec Rivers converge. Optional Detour: Take a right just before the Kennebec Bridge onto the Lake Moxie Road and proceed approx. 2 miles to the Moxie Falls Scenic Area parking lot, where a short 1-mile hike will take you to Maine's highest waterfall with a 92 foot vertical drop, and is well worth the 20 minute walk.
- Return to/Continue on Route 201 Scenic Byway and proceed north to Parlin Pond. There are great opportunities for moose sightings along this route.
- ·Proceed to Attean Overlook and Rest Area and then on to Jackman Village.
- ·From Jackman take a right onto Route 6 and 15 and proceed to Rockwood with views of Mt Kineo.
- ·From Rockwood continue to West and East Outlets—the head of the Kennebec River flowing from Moosehead Lake, and on to Greenville.
- ·From Greenville Center continue Route 15 South thru the villages of Monson and Abbott.
- ·Take a right in Abbott onto Route 16 to Kingsbury Pond and Rest Area, and continue on Route 16 to Bingham.
- ·From Bingham head back north on Route 201 through the Moscow, home of Wyman Dam, and then north along Wyman Lake which has many overlook pullouts and historical sites, such as the Benedict Arnold river crossing site. ·Finish up your loop back here at Maine Lakeside. Without stopping, the loop will take about 3 hours to complete.
